## Baseline Year & Current Reporting Year

### Scope 1

Scope 1 is reported as tCO<sub>2</sub>e in the Baseline Year /Reporting Year due to Panamoure having no boilers, on-site manufacturing, a fleet or f-gases to report emissions on.

### Scope 2

Within Scope 2, we have measured the emissions released from working from home and purchased gas. With all of Panamoure's employees making the most of hybrid working, we have calculated 2 out of 5 days as spent working from home and the other 3 from the office. Heating, lighting and computer consumption have all been taken into account to calculate emissions released due to working from home.

### Scope 3

#### Business Travel

The Business Travel Subset in Scope 3 is reported as 3.84tCO<sub>2</sub>e in 2023 due to Panamoure's business model. Travelling to customers' sites has also been calculated where public transport and petrol cars were used. We are looking to reduce these by having meetings over video conference using programs such as TEAMS.

## Employee Commuting

Within Scope 3 we are currently tracking the modes of transport and types of vehicles Panamoure's employee are using to commute to work. Our employees are able to take advantage of our hybrid working which enable us to reduce our cO<sub>2</sub>e.

## Upstream transportation and distribution

We are tracking our upstream transportation and distribution in detail, Consequently, the subset, Upstream transportation and distribution is reported as 0.02tCO<sub>2</sub>e and Downstream transportation and distribution 0.05tCO<sub>2</sub>e for both our baseline year and our current reporting year.

## Waste generated in operations

We are tracking our CO<sub>2</sub>e released from our waste removal services using we are currently using for the building. Waste generated in operations 0.16 tCO<sub>2</sub>e

## Emissions reduction targets

In order to continue our progress to achieving Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets.

We project that carbon emissions will decrease over the next five years to 28.97 tCO<sub>2</sub>e by 2040. This is a reduction of 5%

## Green Initiatives

- Use natural resources more, reduce energy consumption: Turn off lights when not needed, turn down the heating 1-2 degrees, open windows and close blinds on warm days.
- Encourage remote working for all: Every team member is encouraged to work remotely from home at least 2 days per week.
- Use local suppliers and resources first: Shop locally, use local producers and suppliers.
- Recycle, recycle, recycle: Ensure all recyclable waste is recycled, use separate recycle bins, and educate the team on what can be recycled.
- Only print when essential to reduce printing and paper consumption.
- Buy recyclable or reusable consumables, no to disposable cups, recycled paper, recyclable coffee pods, reusable cups & glasses.
- Car-pooling where possible, colleagues share cars when travelling to the office or client meetings.
